

Public education sessions

Stop It Now! Wales is a child sexual abuse prevention project run by The Lucy Faithfull Foundation, a child protection charity.

Since 2008, we've been working across Wales to make sure children and young people are protected from adverse childhood experiences by preventing child sexual abuse and exploitation. Stop It Now! Wales works in partnership with the Welsh Government to make children, young people and communities safer.

Our public sessions include:

Parents Protect

A session for parents/carers on the facts around child sexual abuse and our responsibility to prevent it. The session can be tailored with information to support families of children with additional needs.

Professionals Protect

A session for professionals on the facts around child sexual abuse and our workplace responsibility to prevent abuse and support families to keep their children safe.

Digital Resilience

A session on issues of internet safety and protecting children and young people from abuse online including the impact on teenage brain development and mental health, an overview of the law in Wales and how to access help and support.

Understanding Harmful Sexual Behaviour

A session on understanding expected developmental healthy behaviours and inappropriate behaviour, how they can cause sexual harm or increase a child's vulnerability, and effective ways of engaging children and young people to speak about possible abuse or harmful sexual behaviour.

Child Sexual Exploitation Awareness

A session giving awareness of how child sexual exploitation can happen, what the risks to children and young people are and what action can be taken, incorporating emerging themes such as county lines and criminal exploitation.

These are free of charge. Hosting would involve you providing a venue and inviting participants, while we will attend and deliver the two-hour sessions.
